
ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT AND PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING STUDY

What is this Project about?

This project is a Webequie First Nation-led environmental assessment and preliminary engineering study of a proposed all-season road connecting Webequie airport with the existing mineral exploration activities and proposed mine developments in the McFaulds Lake area. The purpose of the road would be to move materials, supplies and people between Webequie Airport and the mining-related activities in the McFaulds Lake area.

How will communities be engaged?

The study includes community engagement during the Environmental Assessment (EA) Terms of Reference (ToR) and EA stages of the project. Community engagement will include interviews, small group sessions and workshops with community members to talk about road location alternatives, areas of importance to the communities being consulted, and studies being undertaken.

The Terms of Reference Road Map

The Terms of Reference (ToR) describes how the EA will be prepared, what will be studied, and how Indigenous communities, the public, and government will be consulted during the EA.

Consult and engage with Indigenous communities, the public and

government agencies in order to help Webequie prepare the Draft ToR document

•Provide the Draft ToR to Indigenous communities, the public and government agencies to review and provide comments (30-day review period)

•Incorporate comments and input on the Draft ToR from Indigenous communities, the public and government agencies into the Final ToR

 Submit the Final ToR to the Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP) for review

•The Final ToR will be made available to Indigenous communities, the public and government agencies to provide input during the 30-day review period

•Based on input revieved the MECP will make a decision as whether to approve the Final ToR
